This leaflet describes the key features of MHCSYS, the Mobile Charging System, which helps those businesses involved in letting accommodation on Mobile Home residential sites. MHCSYS manages your charges and receipts for any and all of the services and supplies which will be involved in your business.

MHCSYS is a Microsoft Windows compatible product, running either on a standalone PC or on a network. Almost any PC built within the past 10 years will run MHCSys. The program runs with MS-Access 2003 and later on all versions of Windows from Windows XP to Win10, and on 32-bit or 64-bit architecture.

MHCSYS models all of the aspects of your business. Your Residents and Suppliers, and others, are stored as **Organisations** classified according to their rôles. Many classes of address (current & historical), telecommunications and rôles allow full details to be maintained.

The goods and services which you provide to your residents, those that you provide on your own behalf, and those which you supply from third parties (including electricity and gas) are fully recorded in flexible ways which reflect the way in which they are managed.

MHCSYS uses user-defined codes so that you can be sure that your business can be flexibly represented in the system.

MHCSYS: An Outline

MHCSYS stores the following user-definable types of information:

- Departments** multiple-level accounting headings;
- Organisations and Individuals** are very flexibly defined to allow all kinds of user-defined attributes to be recorded - multiple addresses and telecoms;
- Addresses** unlimited organisation addresses, date ranged and with user-defined types - e.g. Main/Residence/Delivery/Payment;
- Rôles** of individuals and organisations - e.g. resident/customer/supplier;
- Contacts** multiple contact details in each organisation.
- Commodities** the goods and services which you supply to your residential or other customers, on your own behalf, or from third parties - e.g. pitch & garage rentals, electricity, gas, water & sewerage;
- Transactions** link your customers (as residents) with the goods and services which you supply. They are recorded in a flexible way (e.g. allowing for the cumulative manner in which fuel consumption may be measured) to make it easy for you to manage the business;
- Documents Reports** Invoices and receipts can be printed one by one of in batches; a wide variety of standard reports is provided. Invoice, Order, Remittance, and other business forms are built in.
